Bone Marrow Donors Appeal

Daniel Greer (14), is a pupil at Abbey Christian Brothers' Grammar School, Newry.

Anne Greer is appealing for members of the public to come forward in her bid to find a bone marrow donor match to save her 14-year-old son's life.

Anne wants as many people as possible to register to become a stem cell donor.

Anne son Daniel is currently in the Royal Victoria Hospital for Sick Children in Belfast, after having been diagnosed with leukaemia a number of weeks ago.

Daniel, has acute myeloid leukaemia (AML), which is an aggressive form of leukaemia that spreads rapidly.

Daniel's brother James posted on Facebook for people to step forward, saying: "YOU could be the match that Daniel needs! YOU could make the difference!! YOU could be the match that someone on the other side of the world is currently praying for, waiting and hoping that YOU are out there and willing to save their life."
